Dear Partner in the Gospel,

Greetings from Nueva Cordoba. It seems that thousands of people cross our paths in this great city on a daily basis. Among them lies a remnant that God is calling out in these last days as His ekklesia, the True Church of Christ.

"For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit... and able to judge thoughts and intentions of the heart (Heb. 4:12). We have seen the Word of God begin to penetrate the hearts and minds of a few people in the last month, including ourselves. We have seen God at work in so many ways it is hard to write about them in such a few, short lines.

There are many challenges that this area of the city has. It is a very international and national part of the city as many of those who live in this area are from all around the country and other countries. Another challenge is many have a preconceived understanding of who God is, for many "Know about God's righteousness" but are "seeking to establish their own (or don't care), they do not subject themselves to the righteousness of God" (Rom. 10:3). Also, they lead busy, hectic lives in the midst of a culture that thrives on leisure and values time with friends and family.

God is using these factors to our advantage in the beginning of our third month here. Many who long to be leaders or who are looking for career advancement desire to learn English. In other cases, God is directing us to people who are wondering about Him. We are able to boldly stand for Christ, not watering down the Gospel, but through love and the power of the Holy Spirit, we proclaim the only way to eternal life.

We are standing for God proclaiming that He truly exists and that His Scripture is the only true authority. We are standing for Christ proclaiming that He exists eternally, He is God, that through His shed blood there is forgiveness of sins and through His resurrection there is transformation and eternal life. We are seeing the Holy Spirit restrain evil, convict of sin, apply the Word to their hearts, and even regenerate unto new life. And through our study many are beginning to see that they are made for God and that He gives significance to their lives.

The other night I challenged our small group: "After this life, you will stand before God before entering into eternity (life or condemnation), and you will praise Him. No matter how you lived life here, no matter if you were an atheist or a believer, protestant or catholic... you will praise Him on your knees (Rom 14:11)." You will say: "You were right. You are the King." I challenged them first that all that really matters in this temporal life and counts in eternity is if they learned to love and trust Christ, and secondly, after they begin to love and trust Christ, He will show them what He has created them to do. The response is always very positive, but many are still not understanding God's grace. At the very end, I told them that throughout the week, I cry out to God for their salvation. Many of them know that they are lacking, but the great thing is that they are hungry and taking time to process the Word of God.

Their assignment this week is to read 1 John 5:1-12, and to ask God that He would show them their need. Please pray for these souls who hang in the balance.
